White Wine Selection

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| 1 Sauvignon Blanc, Torreon de Parades, Rengo (Chile) | £16.50 |
| Fresh zingy sauvignon full of tropical fruits on the nose, with delicate notes of lemon peel, crisp and round on the palate. Ideal as an aperitif or with light dishes | |
| 2 Ca'Lunghetta, Pinot Grigio, IGT, Scilly (Italy) | £17.50 |
| An elegant bouquet with hints of ripe fruits and flowers, the palate is dry, soft and well balanced with a full bodied structure of refreshing fruit. | |
| 3 Niersteiner Gutes Domtal, Schmitt and Soehne (Germany) | £18.00 |
| From the gently rolling hills of the Rhine hessen, this wine is soft, aromatic and very easy drinking | |
| 4 De Waal Viognier, Stellenbosch (South Africa) | £19.50 |
| With a wonderful peach character, slight notes of blossom and a dry finish this wine is perfect with fish and white meat | |
| 5 Leconfield Chardonnay, Coonawarra (Australia) | £20.00 |
| Rich, ripe full chardonnay showing attractive fresh peach aromas with a touch of mango and pineapple. A background of cinnamon from barrel fermentation in French oak gives an extra dimension. | |
| 6 Santa Ruiz, Albarino, LAN, Rias Biexas (Spain) | £21.00 |
| Albarino now has a cult following and this wine was the first commercially available single varietal to be produced. It is full of stone fruit flavours, crisp and delicate. Ideal with fish | |
| 7 Green Lip Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough (New Zealand) | £21.00 |
| Outstanding sauvignon blanc from the Marlborough region in the South Island. Tropical fruits balanced with fine minerality and good acidity and long expressive finish. | |
| 8 Craggy Range Te Muna Road, Riesling, Martinborough (New Zealand) | £22.50 |
| Roses, fresh nectarine and fresh orange zest dominate the nose whilst the palate has a delicious honey character. The distinctively chalky texture, characteristic of the vineyard, leads to a refreshingly dry finish | |
| 9 Chablis, Reserve de Montaigne, J. Moreau et Fils (France) | £25.00 |
| The wine grows on gentle slope along the perimeter of the Chablis Grand Cru and premiere Cru Appellations. Pale golden colour with slight green tinges and a fruity nose with butter and hazelnut aromas | |
| 10 Pouilly Fuisse, Macon, Louis Latour, Burgandy (France) | £27.50 |
| This wine presents us with aromas of ripe fruits: peach, apricot and grapes. Subtly refined with great length on the palate | |

Rose Wine Selection

11 Ca'Lunghetta Pinot Grigio Rosato, IGT, Sicily (Italy) £17.50
A fresh, aromatic and easy drinking wine. With light hints of summer fruit and a very moreish character, this is a great wine to enjoy with friends and good conversation.

Red Wine Selection

12 Villa Real, Tempranillo/Syrah, La Mancha (Spain) £17.50
From the heart of Spain's wine country, Villa Real have been making wine for over 50 years. Dark spicy black fruit flavours and a medium body

13 Goyenechea, Malbec, Mendoza (Argentina) £19.50
Good fruit with rich flavours combine with the tannins in this well-structured wine to produce an excellent example of what Argentina is capable of.

14 Torreon de Parades Carmenere Reserva, Valle de Rengo (Chile) £19.50
Aromas of black ripe fruits, cherries, blackberries, cassis with black chocolate and vanilla notes from the oak aging

15 De Waal, Pinotage, Stellenbosch (South Africa) £21.00
De Waal were one of the very first vineries in South Africa to plant Pinotage back in 1925. Silky red with smokey notes and lush bramble berries

16 Bodegas LAN Rioja Crianza (Spain) £22.00
Made from 100% Tempranillo, this Crianza spends 12 months in French oak and a further year in bottle before being released for sale. Cherry characters and violets lead to a spicy finish

17 Pinot Noir, Bourgogne, Louis Latour (France) £23.50
An elegant light bodied wine from Burgundy's classic red grape variety, full of soft strawberry flavours

18 Cloof Cellar Blend, Darling (South Africa) £24.00
Medium bodied with soft, ripe tannins and deep berry flavours and a hint of spice. The wine is mouth-watering, juicy and dangerously quaffable!

19 Chateau Layonnat, Lussac St. Emilion (France) £25.50
A soft, rounded, well developed Claret from the Right Bank with the ripe fruit of the merlot grape, perfect with lamb

20 Gigondas, Brotte, Rhone (France) £28.50
Complex, powerful and full bodied in style, the wine has delicious kirsch notes and red berry aromas. Great balance and structure

21 Botter Barolo, DOCG, Piedmont (Italy) £29.50
From the Nebbiolo grape, garnet red with violet and rose aromas. Aged in oak, it has smooth tannins and developed savoury fruit flavours

22 Chardonnay, Red Rock (Australia)

Full of peach and stone fruit character, this easy drinking chardonnay is great with or without food

28 Cabernet Rose, Valdemoro (Chile)

A wine with a lively pink colour of medium intensity, its summer fruit aromas are intense. On the palate the wine is refreshing, light and easy to drink as an aperitif or with any light meals or starters

Champagne & Sparkling Wine

29 Lanson, Black Label Brut (France)

The House tradition of allowing no malolactic fermentation to take place produces a fresh, very crisp and lemony style when young but this will develop more complexity with time. Only grapes from Premier and Grand Cru vineyards are now used.

30 Moet et Chandon (France)

Classic champagne – blended from a third of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay. Matured for at least 3 years in bottle which helps give the wine its typical biscuity flavour.

31 Follador Prosecco Treviso Brut D.O.C. (Italy)

The colour is bright straw yellow with greenish reflections. Fine and persistent bubbles. A very pleasant scent of acacia flowers, golden apple and almond bouquet.

32 Pinot Grigio, Ca'Lunghetta Spumante (Italy)

Made from 100% Pinot Grigio Grapes, this refreshing wine has delicate fruity notes and a medium dry finish. Wonderful sparkling example of one of the most popular grape varieties at the moment

33 Muscat de Beaumes de Venise, Domanie de Coyeux (France)

A rich, luscious and sweet dessert wine with full fruit flavours made from the Muscat grape. This wine comes from a tiny, isolated domaine high up in the hills in the Southern Rhone.
